Rick Hollifield was seen in my office on 12-09-98. The patient had been doing well following a left distal forearm bone graft procedure when he developed spontaneous pain in the distal forearm area. The pain became more acute about two days ago when he attempted to turn the ignition in his car. He reported this afternoon with left distal forearm pain. Radiographs reveal a fracture of the bone plate in the distal radius.

This represents a significant complication in the treatment of this patient. Further surgical intervention will be necessary to repair the bone plate and bone graft the area of the fracture in the distal forearm. Mr. Hollifield is disabled in the use of his left upper limb because of this unfortunate situation.
