Pursuant to the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 7920.000 et seq.), I am formally requesting copies of all public records, inspection logs, accident investigation reports, citations, and enforcement actions maintained by the Division of Occupational Safety and Health (Cal/OSHA) regarding a severe workplace injury that occurred on **August 28, 1996**.

Please search your archives and microfilmed records for any files containing or referencing the following parameters:

- **Date of Incident / Inspection:** On or around August 28, 1996 (including subsequent investigation dates through 1997).
- **Target Entities:** Olsen Steel Incorporated (also known/operating as Olsen & Co. Steel) and/or Kvaas Construction Company, Inc.
- **Location / Project:** The City of San Diego Metropolitan Wastewater Department (MWWd) project located on Convoy Street, San Diego, CA.
- **Records Requested:** All Cal/OSHA Form 36 (Injury/Illness Log), Form 1B (Citation and Notification of Penalty), narrative accident investigation reports, inspector field notes, and witness statements connected to this incident or site during this timeframe.
- I was the first lost-time-injury in over 500,000 man-hours on the project. There has to be some kind of investigation record about it.

Will you please check the archives?

If any portion of these records is deemed exempt from disclosure under California law, please provide the remaining non-exempt portions and specify the exact statutory exemption being invoked for the withheld material.

Thank you for your time and assistance with this historical safety record inquiry. I look forward to your response within the statutory 10-day period.
